1. This is an application filed by applicant **Sau. Pushpa Arvind Khadatkar** for releasing his **Mobile handset Redmi Note 11 Pro+ (6+128) having IMEI No.860041056314183**, in relation to Crime No. 64/2026, u/sec. 12 A of Maharashtra Gambling Act registered at P. S. Nandanwan.
2. Say of Ld. A.P.P. & I.O. were called out.
3. I have heard Ld. Advocate for the applicant and APP for the prosecution at a considerable length. I have also gone through with documents available on record.
4. The applicant submitted that she is resident of Nagpur. She is the owner of **Mobile handset Redmi Note 11 Pro+ (6+128) having IMEI No.860041056314183**. She has submitted that she is the only rightful owner of the aforesaid mobile handsets.
5. The applicant has filed verified copy of Tax Invoice of Mobile handset, verified copy of Aadhar Card and copy of FIR. It prima-facie appears that the above mentioned mobile phone lies in the name of present applicant. It is also important to note that no other person except the present applicant has claimed the said mobile phone till today. Further, if the said mobile is not released then it may cause damage and its condition may deteriorate. Under such circumstances, keeping the said mobile with the police machinery would not serve any purpose.
6. Therefore, considering all these facts and documents available on record, in my view, the said mobile phone can be released upon imposing certain conditions. Resultantly, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. **Mobile handset Redmi Note 11 Pro+ (6+128) having IMEI No.860041056314183** seized in Crime No. 64/2026, U/sec. 12 A of Maharashtra Gambling Act registered at P. S. Nandanwan be given to the applicant **Sau. Pushpa Arvind Khadatkar** upon executing indemnity bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rs. Twenty Thousand only) from her. She shall give such bond to the Investigating Officer / concern P. S.O.
3. Applicant shall not sell, transfer or alienate the aforesaid mobile phone without prior permission of this Court as well as she shall not change its nature till disposal of the matter.
4. Applicant is directed to produce the mobile phone as and when directed by this Court.
5. The Police Officer concerned is directed to prepare detailed panchanama of the mobile phone by taking its photographs and to file the same in the present matter.
6. Applicant shall further submit all the necessary documents regarding the mobile phone with the police.
7. The Investigating Officer / Concern P.S.O. is directed to release the mobile phone upon verification of IMEI Number, as per documents submitted by applicant.
