**State of Maharashtra Vs. Mohd Tousif Asif Ansari**

**ORDER BELOW EXH.27**

- 1] This is an application seeking permission for renewal of passport. It is submitted that prior to registration of offence in CR. No. 38/2018 registered at Ganeshpeth Police Station for offences punishable U/sec.394, 504, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, Sections 4, 25 of the Arms Act and Section 135 of the Maharashtra Police Act, the applicant/accused possessed passport bearing no.M8173680 which was issued on 29/04/2015. The accused is required to visit for future purposes. As per Section 6(2)(1) of Passport Act, 1967 no objection certificate from concern court is necessary for issuing Indian passport. Therefore, the present application.
- 2] Ld. APP filed her say and submitted that, if applicant is allowed then there is possibility of absconding of accused and he will not remain present in the court for facing trial and therefore, prayed for rejection of application.
- 3] Heard Ld. advocate for applicant and Ld. APP. It is seen that, the accused is arrayed as accused in . It is also admitted that accused is on bail. Now the accused wish to renew his passport. Record

reveal that his passport was expired on 28/04/2025. Admittedly, for making foreign visits valid passport is required.

- 4] The accused is seeking permission to renew passport. Looking to the past conduct and pendency of the matter, to my mind, there shall be no hurdle to allow applicant to merely obtain passport at this stage. Accused shall take prior permission before traveling abroad. Therefore, I pass the following order.

### ORDER

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] Issue letter to concern authority regarding no objection only for obtaining passport for the validity of ten years to the accused/applicant **Mohd. Tausif @ Tauseef s/o Asif Ansari** as per prevailing Rules & Regulations.
- 3] On receipt of passport accused shall furnish copy of his passport to the Court.
- 4] Accused/Applicant shall in no case leave the jurisdiction of the court or territory of India without permission of this Court whenever he is intending to leave India.
- 5] The applicant/accused shall furnish his residential address proof along with identity proof.
- 6] In order to achieve uniformity with copy uploaded on CIS, in view of Section 5 of Information Technology Act, 2000, digitally signed copy of the order is placed on record.
