This is a complaint filed under Section 190(1)(a) of the Criminal Procedure Code for the offences under Sections 294, 506-b of the Indian Penal Code. It is seen that as per order dated 05.07.2018, below Exh.1, process is issued against the accused for the aforesaid offences. The accused appeared before the court and furnished bail on 10.08.2018 and since then the matter is pending for framing charge. Since then, the complainant has failed to take effective steps to adduce evidence before charge. It is further seen from the record that since long the complainant as well as the accused have failed to appear before the Court. Today also, none present for the complainant. The matter is more than 8 years old. Consequently, the complaint is liable to be dismissed for want of prosecution under Section 245 read with Section 256 of the Criminal Procedure Code. Hence, the order:-

The complaint is dismissed for want of prosecution and the accused is discharged under Section 245 read with Section 256 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973.
