ORDER BELOW EXH.1 ON PLEA GUILTY

01. Instant matter registered on dated 08.11.2024 as a summons case accused persons are alleged to have committed offence punishable under section 12(a) of the Maharashtra Gambling Prevention Act, 1887.

02. The accused No.1 to 4 are suo-moto appeared before this Court. The accused have filed pursis **Exh.4** along with copy of their Aadhar card **Exh.5 to Exh.8**. They voluntarily filed pursis **Exh.4** and admitted contents of the plea. They voluntarily pleads guilty and admitted their guilt. Accused No.1 to 4 have prayed for lenient view.

03. Accused No. 1 to 4 have submitted that this is a first offence. Accused No.1 to 4 will not commit any offence in future. They have filed a pursis at **Exh.4** stating that their family is totally depended upon them. Their economical condition is poor. I also considered nature of offence, age of accused and their economical condition. I found that, the accused is entitled for Lenient view. Hence, the order.

ORDER

- 1) The accused No.1) Goyal Ramesh Dhoke, 2) Raj Dnyaneshwar Barsagade, 3) Rajendra Lahanuji Mendhe and 4) Shrawan Manik Mohankar are convicted of the offence punishable u/s. 12(a) of the Maharashtra Gambling Prevention Act, 1887 and they are sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment till rising of the court and to pay a fine of **Rs. 500/-** in word (**Rs. Five Hundreds Only**) **each**. In default of payment of fine, they shall undergo of simple imprisonment for the period of 3 days.
- 2) The case is disposed of and proceeding is closed.
- 3) Bail bonds of the accused are forfeited.
- 4) After appeal period, seized
 - i) seized cash amount of Rs. 4840/- be forfeited and credited to the Government.
 - ii) 52 playing cards be destroyed.
