This is a complaint filed under Section 190(1)(a) of the Criminal Procedure Code for the offences under Sections 448, 452, 323, 506, 363, 348, 147, 109, 10-B read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code. Report under Section 202 of the Criminal Procedure Code is filed by Police Station Ajni on 12.04.2016, which is at Exh.12. Since then, the matter is pending for hearing on issuance of process. It is further seen that since prior to June, 2022, the complainant has remained absent. On 05.05.2025, the Ld. Counsel for the complainant has filed pursis (Exh.18), stating that the complainant is not in contact with him. Thereafter, the notice was issued to the complainant on Court's Motion, but her presence could not be secured. Therefore, the matter is posted for dismissal order. Even today, the complainant has failed to appear to take steps. The matter is more than 12 years old. Consequently, the complaint is liable to be dismissed for want of prosecution under Section 203 read with Section 256 of the Criminal Procedure Code. Hence, the order:-

ORDER

The complaint is dismissed for want of prosecution and the accused are acquitted under Section 203 read with Section 256 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973.
