This is a complaint filed under Section 190(1)(a) of the Criminal Procedure Code for the offences punishable under Sections 18(a)(i), 18(a)(vi), 16, punishable under Section 27(d) of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940, in the year 2014. Since then, the complainant has failed to take effective steps to secure the presence of the accused. Though the complainant is registered as Regular Criminal case, the aforesaid offences are triable summarily under Section 36-A of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act. As per Rojnama, the complainant has failed to remain present since long. Therefore, the complaint can be dismissed under Section 256 of the Criminal Procedure Code and the accused are entitled to be acquitted. Hence, the order-

**ORDER**

The complaint is dismissed for want of prosecution under Section 256 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 and the accused are entitled to be acquitted.
