**State Vs. Gaurav Jaiswal**

**ORDER BELOW EXH.1**

(Passed on 10.03.2026)

The offence punishable u/s. 269,270 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 65(e), 83 of the Maharashtra Prohibition Act, 1949 is levelled against the accused. Perused the record. The case was registered on 18.09.2020.

2. The matter is more than five years old and summary in nature. Despite several opportunities since 2020, the prosecution has failed to secure presence of the witnesses despite of issuance of summons for several times. There seems no possibility that the prosecution will secure the presence of witnesses in future. The accused have fundamental right of speedy trial. In such circumstances, no purpose will be served in keeping the matter pending. In view of the above discussion, I pass the following order-

**Operative Order**

1. The proceeding in the present matter is stopped u/s. 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
2. The accused are released (discharged) for the offence punishable u/s. 269,270 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 65(e), 83 of the Maharashtra Prohibition Act, 1949.
3. The bail bonds of the accused stand cancelled.
4. The seized muddemal i.e. 09 bottles of liquor, 750 ml. each be

sent to Collector, Excise Department, Nagpur for disposal as per rules, after the expiry of appeal period.
