I have obtained my MBBS Decgree in 1986 and since then I am practicing as a Doctor in Roy Hospital Kamptee since 1992. On 12/02/2011 Anil Bhimrao Patil was brought by his mother Chandrakanta Patil at my hospital at 08.00 a.m. There was history of stab injury over right lower abdomen. I admitted that patient and examined his person. Upon examination Anil Patil, I found following injuries :

- [1] Stab wound over right illiac fosa, size of the injury was 3 x 2 cm by intra-peritoneal deep. The margins were clean cut, edges were sharp and red in color.
- [2] The patient was operated for the same and the intra-operative findings were stabbed wound of size 2 x 1 cm in terminal illeum about 10 cm proximal to I.C. junction. There was hemeoperitoneum with fical matters in peritonium.
- [3] incised wound of 3 x 2 x ½ cm in left elbow posterior aspect.

The nature of first and second injuries was grievous and the third one was simple injury. When patient reached my hospital, I immediately informed police station Kamptee by letter. Now I shown the letter which is filed with chargesheet, it bears the signature of my medical officer Dr. Vanita Kolhe. I identified her signature because she worked with me for so many years. At the time of emergency

patient, the medical officer who is present in the Casualty Ward always attend the patient. The contents of the letter are true, it is marked as **Exh. 29**.

Accordingly I issued medico legal certificate. The medical certificate now shown to me, it is the same. The contents therein are written in my handwriting and are true and correct. It seems torn where I have signed the certificate. Today I brought the Carbon Copy of the certificate which was issued by me. When I issued the original injury certificate, I make the second copy by putting the carbon below the original certificate. Today I have filed the verified copy of the injury certificate brought by me. The contents of the original, the carbon copy which is brought by me and the copy of the carbon copy which is filed today on record are one and the same and are true and correct. The carbon copy contains my signature. So the copy filed today on record is also have my signature. Both the medical certificates are marked as **Exh.30 and 31**.

The injuries can be possible by knife as well as sharp, hard, pointed object.

**Chief examination over.**

**Cross-examination by Adv. Mr. Ramteke**

It is true to say that when I examined the patient, I have not seen the weapon. It is not true to say that the injury shows the full penetration of the weapon. It is not true to say that as there was no weapon at the time of examination of the patient, I could not tell the size of the wound. It is not true to say that the nature of weapon is not mentioned on Exh.31. It is not true to say that age of injury is not mentioned in the certificate. Witness volunteers that the color of

the injury as red, it indicates the age of the injury as fresh. Red color injury means the the injuries within 8 hours. It is not true to say that I have not examined the patient and I h ave not issued the certificate Exh. 29, 30 and 31 as per the injuries sustained by the patient. It is not true to say that injuries mentioned above are possible if a person falls on a sharp pointed stem. It is not true to say that I am deposing false.
