ORDER (BELOW EXH.1)

Today there is a Special Drive for disposing unattended, petty, stale, ineffective and old cases under Sections 256 and 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in view of the Hon'ble District and Sessions Court, Nagpur letter No.217/TW-JB/2026 dated 21.02.2026.

2. Perused the record. The complainant filed this complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. The complainant is absent since long. The complainant did not take any steps against the accused since long. Hence, vide order dated 08.07.2025 passed below Exh.1, the case is fixed for dismissal order. Thereafter also on 08.08.2025, 16.08.2025, 13.09.2025, 06.11.2025, 13.12.2025 and 09.01.2026 the complainant remained absent. Today also the complainant and his Advocate are absent when called out repeatedly till 01.30 p.m. It seems that the complainant is no more interested in prosecuting the case. The case is pending since 06.07.2019 i.e. more than 06 and half years old. Therefore, as per directions of Hon'ble High Court and Hon'ble District Court, Nagpur, no purpose would be served by keeping the case pending without any progress. Thus, the case is liable to be dismissed in default. Hence, I pass following order :-

ORDER

1. The case is dismissed for want of prosecution.
2. The accused is acquitted for the offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

3. The case is disposed of accordingly.
