



- 1) This is the application under Order 06 Rule 17 of the Civil Procedure Code for amendment of plaint.
- 2) By this application, Plaintiff contended that, that while preparing the affidavit examination-in-chief, it came to the knowledge of the Plaintiff that, inadvertently the schedule is not appended with the plaint and therefore Plaintiff deserves to seek proposed amendment as schedule of the property as mention in the present application. It is further contended that, if the proposed amendment will be carried out, it will not caused any prejudice to the Defendant. It also not changed the nature of the suit and hence amendment needs to be granted.
- 3) The Defendant filed no objection for carrying out such amendment. In view of the no objection of the Defendant and considering the contends in the application. It transpire to me that, the proposed amendment found to be just and proper. If such amendment will not be carried out then it will caused prejudice to the Plaintiff. Moreover, such amendment will not change the nature of the nature of the suit property as the proposed amendment only in respect of the schedule of the property. Hence, in my considered opinion, application needs to be granted. Hence, in view of the above discussion, I pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1) Application is granted.
- 2) Plaintiff is directed to carry out amendment forthwith.
- 3) Plaintiff is directed to file copy of amendment plaint.
