- 06] Whether the original plaintiff proves that, she is entitled for partition and separate possession of her 1/5th share in suit property as prayed ?
- 07] Whether the original plaintiff proves that, defendants

without right, title and interest are trying to dispose off suit property ?

- 08] Whether the original defendant (plaintiffs) proves that, they are entitled for declaration as prayed ?
- 09] Whether the original defendant (plaintiffs) proves that, they are entitled for partition and separate possession of 1/6th share in suit properties as prayed ?
- 10] Whether the original defendant (plaintiffs) proves that, they are entitled for permanent injunction as prayed ?
- 11] What order and decree ?
