

ORDER BELOW EXH.1 in RCC No. 314 of 2015

State vs. Ramesh

1) Perused case record. This case is pending since many years. Say of informant was called relying on the contents of para 22 of the authority namely Y. P. Baiju vs. State of Kerala and Another, 2008 Cr.L.J. 928.

2) Informant Shri. Bharat Sitaram Bangle in Crime Number 102 of 2014 of Kelwad Police Station is present today in court with learned APP Shri. A. A. Kore for prosecution. Informant has submitted pursis (Exh.14) contending therein that he does not intend to proceed further with this case. Contents of said pursis (Exh.14) are verified from informant who agree to them voluntarily. Composition under Section 320 of Code of Criminal Procedure is unilateral act. Stage of compounding also does not matters. Hence, permission is granted to informant to compound matter unilaterally as the same is submitted through prosecution wing. In the result, I proceed to pass order as under:

1) Accused in this case stand acquitted for offences under Sections 429 of Indian Penal Code as per Section 320 (8) of Code of Criminal Procedure.
