**ORDER BELOW EXH. 9**

By way of present application, the D.H. seeking for issuance of attachment warrant against the J.D. for recovery of Rs.1,02,682/-. The applicant submitted that, the J.D. failed to deposit the amount as per the order. Hence, application deserves to be allowed.

2. Matter proceeded *ex-parte* against the J.D.
3. Heard learned Counsel for applicant. Perused the record. The learned Co-operative Court Nagpur by order dated 10/10/2022 in Dispute No. 130 of 2016 pleased to direct the J.D. to pay Rs.54,198/- along with future interest @ 15% p. a.
4. As J. D. failed to comply the order, D. H. filed present execution proceeding. In present matter also the J.D. no. 1 to 3 duly served, still they chosen to remain absent. Hence matter proceeded *ex-parte* against them. There is no justifiable reason for J.D.'s non compliance. Hence, it is necessary to issue the attachment warrant against the J.D., as per Order XXI Rule 30 of C.P.C. for the recovery of due amount. Issue process accordingly.
