Chief-examination by Shri. J. M. Borkar Ld. A.P.P for State:-

1) I owned degree in BAMS. On dated 01/03/2023 I was working as Medical Officer at P. H. C. Sirsi. PSO, Bela gave me one letter on dated 01/03/2023 at 9.00 am. Now, that letter shown to me it bears signature of PSO, Sirsi contents therein are true and correct, that letter marked at **Exh.20**.

2) On same date patient namely Rahul Arun Mendhule age 32, male, R/o. Salebhatti Tq-Bhivaput was brought before me by Krunal Thakur PC. After examination I found following injuries:-

He narrated history of assault by means of wooden stick. Identification marked noted as a mole on right hand wrist, after examination I found following injuries.

a) Lacerated injury on head, 2X2 Cm.

Age of injury was fresh, probable cause of injury by means of hard and blunt object. Healing time of injuries simple without complications of any associated of internal injury. According to my opinion patient will be recovered within 7 to 15 days. Then I prepared MLC certificate Now, it is shown to me it bears thumb

impression of patient and my signature thereon along with stamp of Hospital contents are true and correct. It is marked at Exh.21

3) Thereafter, one letter issued from PSO, Sirsi for preparation of query report. Now, letter dated 08/03/2023 shown to me it bears signature of Krunal Thakur PC, he was signed before me thereby I identified his signature. contents incorporated therein are true and correct. It marked at **Exh.22.**

4) Thereafter, I prepared query report. Now, it is shown to me it is contended that I had examine weapon brought by PC. Krunal Thakur at PHC, Sirsi, name of the weapon is contended as a wooden stick, nature-hard and blunt object. Measurement five nobse, length-84 Cm, round circumference 10 Cm, middle circumference 7.5 Cm, others end circumference 7 Cm. Injuries mentioned in MLC report of patient namely Rahul Arun Mendhule done by me on dated 01/03/2023. Injury could be caused by this weapon. Thereafter, I sealed the weapon and handed over to the PC. Krunal Thakur. Accordingly I prepared query report it bears my signature and stamp contents incorporated therein are true and correct. It marked at **Exh.23.**

Chief-examination is over.

Cross-examination by Adv. R.B.Bhombe for all accused :-

5) I am unable to remind whether the letters Exh.20 and 22 brought before me already signed by Krunal Thakur or not. It is true to say that, instead of signature contended on Exh.20 and

22 I never seen the signature of Krunal Thaur. It is not true to say that, as I did not see the other signature of Krunal Thakur on other documents and thereby I can not say the signature contended in Exh.20 and 22 does not bears the signature of Krunal Thakur.

Que-How you can ascertain the signature of Krunal Thakur of Exh.20 and 22?

Ans-Because these Exh.20 and 22 brought before me and it was already signed by Krunal Thakur. Because, Krunal Thakur was present in Hospital.

It is true to say that as the Exh.20 and 22 were brought by Krunal Thakur and produced before me and thereby, I saying that it was signed by Krunal Thakur.

6) It is true to say that, we maintain register to keep the record of letter received in our Hospital. Now, Exh.20 and 22 shown to me it does not bear inward number. It is true to say that, there is no remark over these Exh.20 and 22 as it was received by PHC, Sirsi. It is true to say that, there is correction in the date mention in Exh.20.

7) It is true to say that, as per law though I am holding BAMS degree but, I can use allopathic treatment. It is true to say that, in Sirsi PHC senior MBBS doctors also practicing.

Que-Whether your senior doctor order you to prepared MLC of patient?

Ans-As I was on duty, I prepared MLC.

It is not true to say that, as I owned degree in BAMS and thereby, I am not authorized to refer allopathic medicine like diclofenac. It is

true to say that, as I owned degree in BAMS I was not authorized to prepared this MLC at Exh.21. It is true to say that, below thumb impression at Exh.21 I did not write the name of person who's thumb impression obtain thereon.

8) Lacerated wound means deep cut. If, there is deep cut injury it may be caused by means of hard blunt and sharp object. It is true to say that, weapon referred in query report at Exh.23 it does not having sharp adge. It is true to say that, there is correction in dimension of weapon in Exh.23 query report and I did not signed beside the correction. It is not true to say that, as per the say of informant I prepared MLC at Exh.21. It is not true to say that, as I not authorized to prepared MLC and thereby, I prepared false MLC certificate. It is not true to say that, I prepared false query report at Exh.23. It is true to say that, there is specific format for issuance of MLC certificate. It is true to say that, I have not prepared MLC certificate within the specific format. It is true to say that, I have not mention the age of injury in hours. It is true to say that, I have not mentioned the colour of injury in MLC certificate. It is not true to say that, I prepared false MLC certificate and thereby, I did not mention the colours of injury and age of injury in hours. It is not true to say that, as I knows the informant and thereby I prepared false MLC certificate.

Cross-examination is over.
