ISSUES

1] Does the plaintiff prove that the suit properties are the ancestral/joint family properties of plaintiff and defendants ?

2] Does the plaintiff prove that defendant No. 1 and 2 are earning income out of suit properties ?

3] Does the plaintiff prove that mutation excluding her name from revenue record of the suit properties are illegal ?

4] Do the defendants prove that suit property bearing No. 116 and 117 are the self acquired properties ?

5] Do the defendants prove that suit property bearing No.115 is separate property received in a compromise in RCS No. 39/99 ?

6] Do the defendants prove that suit property bearing No. 336, 328, 329, 337/1, 2, & 3 are separate properties given to them by Will by mother and father ?

7] Whether the plaintiff has a share on partition of suit properties ? If Yes, what is her share ?

8] Is the plaintiff entitled to partition in metes and bounds and separate possession of share ?

9] Is the plaintiff entitled to mesne profits ? If yes, at what rate ?

10] Is the plaintiff entitled to a declaration that mutations are illegal and not binding ?

11] Do the defendants prove that the suit is baseless and they are

entitled to costs ? If yes, At what rate ?
