

ORDER PASSED BELOW EXH.1.

The applicants have claimed heirship certificate under the Bombay Regulation Act,1827 on the ground of legal heirs of deceased Laxman Kawduji Dadmal and Veena Laxmanrao Dadmal.

2. It is the contention of the applicants that, Laxman Kawduji Dadmal died on 31.01.2022 and Veena Laxmanrao Dadmal died on 03/12/2014 leaving behind applicants. Applicant No. 1 is son and applicant No. 2 is daughter of the deceased Laxman Kawduji Dadmal and Veena Laxmanrao Dadmal. Except the above said applicants there are no legal heirs left by deceased Laxman Kawduji Dadmal and Veena Laxmanrao Dadmal. The applicants are in need of legal heirship certificate in their favour.

3. In pursuance to the application, citation notice Exh.11 as well as paper publication in daily Dainik Bhaskar newspaper dated 22/01/2026 vide Exh.16 was issued and thereby objections were called. But, none was appeared and objected the claim of applicants as heirs of deceased Laxman Kawduji Dadmal and Veena Laxmanrao Dadmal.

4. Applicant No.1 Badal Laxman Dadmal adduced his evidence by way of affidavit vide Exh.10. In support of their claim, they relied on death certificate of deceased Laxman Kawduji Dadmal at Exh.12 and death certificate of deceased Veena Laxmanrao Dadmal at Exh.13. They also relied on daily *Dainik Bhaskar* newspaper at Exh.16. So also applicant has filed verified copies of Aadhar Card of applicant Nos.1 and 2 at Exh.14 and

Article 15 respectively. The learned counsel of the applicants closed evidence by filing pursis Exh.17. The evidence of applicant No.1 Badal Laxman Dadmal remained unchallenged as none appeared to oppose. It is established by the death certificate of Laxman Kawduji Dadmal that he had been died on 31/01/2022. So also wife of Laxman Kawduji Dadmal already died on dated 03/12/2014 . From the documents, it is formally established that the applicants are the legal heirs of deceased Laxman Kawduji Dadmal and Veena Laxmanrao Dadmal. Therefore, I am inclined formally to hold that the applicants are the legal heirs of deceased Laxman Kawduji Dadmal and Veena Laxmanrao Dadmal. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. Issue heirship certificate in the name of applicant Nos.1]Shri.Badal S/o. Laxman Dadmal and 2] Ku. Himani D/o. Laxman Dadmal as prayed in para No.9(a),after payment of necessary Court fee, if any, stating therein that, the applicants are surviving legal heirs of the deceased Laxman Kawduji Dadmal and Veena Laxmanrao Dadmal.
3. On compliance of necessary formalities in this order a heirship certificate in terms of schedule B of the Bombay Regulation 1827 shall be given to applicants.
4. Present application is accordingly disposed off for the compliance by the applicants.
