

**Succession No. 11/2025**  
**Sunita Vs. Manager +1**

**ORDER BELOW EXH. 5**  
( Passed on this 22<sup>nd</sup> December-2025)

Read the application and record. Heard Ld. Adv. Shri Mandavkar for applicant. The main petition is filed seeking Succession Certificate. It is submitted that applicant Sunita is married daughter of Shri Shyamrao s/o Atmaram Samarth. Copy of Aadhar card of Shri Shyamrao is filed on record. Copy of Pan Card of applicant is on record. It shows her name as Sunita Sunil Khedikar/Shamrao Atmaramji Samarth. Copy of first page of Passbook bearing account No. 504810110001400 is filed on record. It stands in the name of Shyamrao. It is of Vidarbha Konkan Gramin Bank, branch Umred. Another number 66703023666 is mentioned on it. Shri Mandaokar submits that such new number has been given to the said account after the merging of above bank in respondent No. 1 Maharashtra Gramin Bank. Photo copy of FD bearing account No. 66703072331 is filed on record. It stands in the name of Shyamrao in the above bank. It is of the amount of Rs. 9,00,000/-. Shyamrao died on 3-12-2025. Photo copy of card is on record. It shows that dashkriya program of Shyamrao was held on 12-12-2025. Name of respondent No. 2 Atul is mentioned on it as nephew. Applicant submits that she does not know much about the above account and F.D. Therefore, she had been to respondent No.1 bank. She came to know that name of respondent No. 2 is mentioned as nominee in above account and FD and bank official has informed her that bank would pay the amount to respondent No. 2 as nominee. Therefore, she sent notice on 09-12-2025 requesting the bank for not to make payment to respondent No.2 on the ground that she is the only legal heir of late Shyamrao. Present main petition is filed by her seeking Succession Certificate in her name. Her another prayer in it is to stop respondent No. 1 from making payment to respondent No. 2 till the decision of main petition. She apprehends that bank may pay the amount to respondent No. 2, therefore, present application Exh. 5 is filed seeking prohibitory injunction order against respondent no.1 bank. At this stage, it is requested to pass ad-interim exparte injunction to that effect till the next date. I find

substance in such prayer. Therefore, I pass following order.

**ORDER**

1. Respondent No.1 Bank shall not pay the amount of account number account No. 504810110001400 (New number 66703023666) and F.D. No. 66703072331, to respondent No. 2 till the date 20-01-2026.
2. Issue notice to the respondents calling upon them to show cause as to why such relief shall not be granted as is prayed in this application.
