ORDER

The accused filed a pursis at Exh. 02 and stated that he want to plead guilty. It appears that the accused is pleading guilty voluntarily in spite of consequences of punishment explained to him in Marathi language. Heard the accused on point of sentence. He submitted that he is poor, therefore lenient view may be taken. No previous criminal antecedents have been shown against accused. Considering nature of offence and submissions of accused, lenient view will have to be taken. Hence, I accept his plea being voluntarily made and proceed to pass the following order :-

OPERATIVE ORDER

1. The accused is convicted for the offence punishable under Section 12(a) of the Maharashtra Prevention of Gambling Act, 1887 vide Section 275 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment till rising of the Court and each of them to pay a fine of Rs. 200/- (Rs. Two Hundred only), in default, to suffer simple imprisonment for 03 days.

2. Seized muddemal property i.e.
 - i) Rs. 8,900/- as per record is not claimed by anybody, hence it be forfeited to State Government after the appeal period is over.

 - ii) 3 Seized two wheelers are already back to the accused persons as per the pursis at Exh. 02. Hence, their custody is made permanent after the appeal period.

 - iii) Out of 7 seized mobile phones, 2 are already returned to the accused persons as per pursis at Exh.,. 02. The custody of the phones are made permanent after the appeal period.

 - iv) Out of 7 seized mobile phones, remaining 5 be returned to the owners on identification and submission of relevant document.

 - v) Sattapatti and one ball pen, being worthless, be destroyed after the appeal period is over.
