**ORDER PASSED EXH.NO.5**

1. Read plaint and application Exh.5. Also perused the documents filed on record. Heard the learned advocate Shri.A.N.Narnavre for the plaintiff.

2. Plaintiff has filed this suit for declaration and permanent injunction. Plaintiff has also filed an application under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 and section 151 of C.P.C. Plaintiff further contended that the defendant has issued notice to him for disconnecting the electricity connection over the well situated in field survey no.920. Therefore, plaintiff is praying to grant ad-interim temporary injunction against defendant, from disconnection of electricity supply over the suit well, till appearance of defendant or till filing of say.

3. On going through the averments made in the plaint and application Exh.5, at this stage I do not find any prima facie case to grant ad-interim ex parte temporary injunction in favour of plaintiff. No extraordinary and exceptional case is made out to grant ad-interim relief in favour of plaintiff. Moreover, it is principle of natural justice to hear the other side before passing any order against them. No prejudice will be caused to plaintiff. Hence, I proceed to pass following order-

**ORDER**

- 1) Issue show cause notice to defendant as to why temporary injunction claimed against him should not be granted in favour of plaintiff, returnable on 06.03.2025.
- 2) EP and SB, if any, be allowed.
