ORDER BELOW EXH.13

The defendants have filed an application under Order VII Rule-11(f) of the Code of Civil Procedure. Ld. Advocate of the defendants has submitted that, plaintiffs have not issued copy of plaint and other documents with the suit summons as required as per rule-9 of Order-VII, therefore, plaint is liable to be rejected.

2. On the other hand, plaintiffs have filed their reply on the application itself and submitted that, defendants have already received the documents by hand on 13/06/2025, therefore, present application is liable to be rejected.

3. Heard both the sides. It needs to mention here that, in view of order VII R-9 of the Code of Civil Procedure plaintiff is under obligation provide as many copies of the plaint as there are defendants within seven days from the date of service of summons. In the instant case, it is seen that, defendant no.1 had obtained copies of plaint and documents on 13/06/2025. It means that, defendant no.1 has already obtained the necessary documents. Moreover, present application is moved by only defendant no.1. Thus,compliance under O-VII R-9 is done in respect of defendant no.1. Thus, under these circumstances, I am inclined to hold that the objection raised by defendant no.1 is not sustainable. Thus, present application is required to be rejected. Hence, I pass following order-
