State Vs. Mohd Jubair

**ORDER BELOW EXH.01**  
**(Passed on dated 10/03/2026)**

The present application is filed by applicant Mohd. Jubair S/o Mohd. Laiq for release the 22 he Buffalo's on Supurtnama. The said animals are seized in crime No. 100/2026 [under Section 11(1)(D) (E) (H) of Animal to Cruelty Act, by Police Station Deolapar.

2] In short, the story of applicant is as under :-

That, the applicant is agriculturist and having a business of selling and purchasing he buffalo's and maintain his family. He has purchased 22 he buffalo's as mentioned in the application. Applicant has purchased the 22 he buffalo's for seeling the said animals in the Market of Hyderabad(telangana). That accordingly Zilla Panchayat Mujaffarnagar Pashu Paith, Nasirpur Baipas has issued the receipts on 21.02.2026. The applicant is the owner of the said animals and the total approximate value of the said animals are Rs. 14,31,500/-. The said animals are kept in Gou-Vigyan Anusandhan Kendra, At Deolapar. Tah. Ramtek, i.e. to non-applicant. The said animals are seized in the Crime No. 100/2026 by P. S. Delopar. Hence, the applicant prayed for release 22 he Buffalo's on Supurtnama. He is ready to abide all terms and conditions, which will be imposed by this Court.

3] The APP. by filing say on this application strongly opposed

on the ground that the investigation is in progress. Offence is non-bailable. In this case there is the involvement of accused person in the crime. The applicant failed to file sufficient documents to show his legal ownership and possession regarding seized animals. The I.O. also by filing say at Exh. 4 strongly opposed to release the said animals. Considering the say of I.O. and the above mentioned facts, the Hon'ble Court may reject the instant application. Hence, prayed for reject the application. The said Gorakhsan Sanstha has not filed say even after sufficient opportunities are given.

4] Heard. Perused the record. The Advocate of applicant argued that, The applicant has purchased the said animals for selling in Market of Hyderabad. He has filed 22 receipts issued by Zilla Panchayat Mujaffarnagar Pashu Paith, Nasirpur Baipas and certificate of fitness to travel cattle of veterinary hospital at Mujaffarnagar Nagar. Applicant is the owner of the said animals and he requires the said animal for his business purpose. Applicant is ready to abide all the conditions which the court may imposed. Considering the business of applicant, it would be appropriate to allow the present application. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

### **ORDER**

1. Application is allowed.
2. The 22 he Buffalo's are seized by Deolapar Police Station in crime No. 100/2026 is hereby directed to release on Supurtnama of Rs. 14,32,000/-.
3. The Investigation officer is directed to draw proper panchanama and to take photographs of the seized animals before handing over possession of the same to the

applicant and to produce the same along with final report.

4. The applicant is hereby directed to pay Rs.100/- per cattle to Gou-Vigyan Anusandhan Kendra, At Deolapar. Tah. Ramtek, Dist. Nagpur from the date 28/02/2026 to till actual release of these 22 he Buffalo's.
