That, you all accused along with other accused in this case on 20.02.2021 in between 03.00 to 04.50 hours at Mouza Manegaon Tek, Tah. Ramtek found 'playing jugar' in the public place in contravention of provision under section 12(a) of the Maharashtra Prevention of Gambling Act, and within my cognizance.

6.Plea of the accused :-

Q. 1 :-Do you understood the charges now read over ?

Q. 3 :-Do you plead guilty ?

ORDER

Particulars of offences against accused is framed at Exh.04. It is explained in vernacular to the accused persons. They pleaded guilty. I have personally verified accused persons. They stood abide by their plea of guilt. It is found voluntary. Hence, I have no hesitation in admitting their plea of guilt. Thus, on their plea of guilt, accused are hereby convicted for the offence punishable u/s. 12-a of the Maharashtra Prevention of Gambling Act.

At this point I take a pause to hear the accused persons on the point of sentence. Accused have submitted that they are poor and illiterate persons. They have urged for imposing of minimum fine.

Having given anxious thought to the submissions of the accused persons and the facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the opinion that it is necessary to impose such a punishment that accused persons should understand the seriousness of their acts and deeds. In this case, the accused persons filed pursis (Exh. 03) stating that they did not want to claim amount seized by the police in the crime. Hence, it would be decided after final disposal of the case. Hence, on the backdrop of

above discussion, I proceed to pass following order :-

ORDER

- 1) **Accused No.1 Vijay S/o. Bidprasad Gupta, accused No.7 Rahul S/o. Rajendraprasad Jayswal and accused No.10 Milind S/o. Ramesh Jaiswal** are hereby convicted for the offence punishable u/s. 12(a) of the Maharashtra Prevention of Gambling Act vide section 252 of Code of Criminal Procedure and they are sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment till rising of Court and also to pay fine of Rs. 300/- (Three Hundred Rupees only) **each** in default of which to suffer simple imprisonment for One day.
- 2) Case with proceed against accused No. 2 to 6, 8, 9, 11 to 17 only.
- 3) Copy of Judgment be given to the accused persons free of costs.
