**JUDGEMENT**

(Delivered on 13/10/2023)

I called accused ensuring voluntariness of the pleading guilty. Despite explaining consequences, accused shown their readiness and willingness to plead guilty. I satisfy myself that accused are pleading guilty without having been influenced by any factors such as coercion, duress and temptation. The consequences of pleading guilty have been explained to them still they plead guilty and asked for leniency in the punishment. Accused submit that, this is their first offence. Accused further submit that they are the only bread winner in the family and are poor, hence their condition may be considered. Considering the application and submission of accused, their plea is accepted. In view of this discussion, I pass the following order:-

**ORDER**

1. Accused No.6 Atul Ambalal Uike, **No.12 Bunesh Chandanlal Lihare , No.13 Salil Hemant Choukase, No.15 Nitesh Rajendraprasad Gupta & No.17 Ishad Khan Mohd. Nazir Khan** are convicted for the offence under Section 12(a) of the Maharashtra Prevention of Gambling Act vide Section 252 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and they are sentenced to pay fine of Rs.300/- (Rupees Three Hundred only) each, in default of payment of fine to suffer simple imprisonment for 10 days each.
2. Case be proceed against accused No.2 to 5, 8, 9, 11, 14 & 16 only
3. Copy of judgment be given to the accused persons free of costs.
