The non-applicant no.4 has filed an application for setting aside ex-parte order passed below Exh.1 dated 03/10/2024. Ld. Advocate of the non-applicant no.4 has submitted that non-applicant no.4 could not appear before the Court. However, present non-applicant has valuable interest in the subject matter, therefore, ex-parte order may be set aside.

2. On the other hand, Ld. Advocate of applicant has put his objection.

3. Heard both sides. I must mention here that the reason given by non-applicant no.4 is not just. However, in the interest of natural justice and in order to decide matter on merit, ex-parre order passed below Exh.1 dated 03/10/2024, is required to be set aside subject to costs of Rs. 300/- in the interest of natural justice. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

- 1) Application is allowed subject to costs of Rs. 300/-.
