The defendant No.10 has filed an application for permission to file written-statement on record. Ld. Advocate of defendant No. 10 has submitted that, defendant no. 10 has under impression that he already has filed his written statement and hence, he could not file his written statement within a stipulated period and hence, permission may be given to file written statement in the interest of natural justice.

2] On the other hand, plaintiff has not filed his reply.

3] Heard learned advocate of defendant no.10. It is to be noted here that, the reason given by defendant No.10 is not entirely just. However, in order to decide the suit on merit and in the interest of natural justice, defendant No.10 is required to be given fair chance to defend his case. Therefore, permission is required to be given to file written-statement on record subject to cost of Rs.1000/-. Hence, I proceed to pass following order-

ORDER

- 1) Application is allowed, subject to cost of Rs.1000/-.
- 2) Costs be given to the plaintiff after payment being made.
