



Order below Exh. No. 1
(Order Passed on 12.03.2026)

As per the direction of the Hon'ble of High Court vide letter No.8(Gen)-10001/2026-2023,dtd. 18/2/2026 and direction of the Hon'ble Principle District & Session Judge, Nagpur vide letter No.217/TW-JB/2026 dtd.21/02/2026. This case is taken on today's board in special drive. On perusal of record it appears that charge sheet has been filed on 21-11-2023 for offence punishable under Section 12(a) of The Maharashtra Prevention of Gambling Act. Particulars of the offence recorded against the accused and accused pleaded not guilty. Hence, summons issued to all witnesses, In-spite service of summons to Informant, and other police witness also issuance of Bailable Warrant against panch witness all remained absent. It shows that all listed witnesses are absent despite service of summons. Sufficient opportunity to secure the presence of witness has been given to the prosecution but prosecution failed to secure the presence of witnesses. Therefore there is no point in keeping the case pending further. Moreover the matter is summarily triable. Hence, this is a fit case for stop proceeding as per Section 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. Hence, I pass the following order :-

ORDER

1. Further proceeding of this matter is hereby stopped

as per Section 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

2. The accused is released as per section 258 of Cr.P.C.for the offence punishable under section 12(a) of The Maharashtra Prevention of Gambling Act..
3. The bail bond of the accused stands cancelled and surety is hereby discharged.
4. Seized Muddemal satta patti paper and one blue pen be destroyed, cash Rs. 640/- (Six hundred and forty rupees only) be credited to government after the appeal period is over.
