5. Whether the plaintiff proves that, the defendant Nos.1 to 3 are creating third party interest in the suit properties ?
6. Whether the plaintiff proves that, Sale Deed document No.524/2022 executed on 25.03.2022 in favour of the defendant Nos.4 to 6 is not binding upon the plaintiffs ?
7. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to get relief as prayed for ?
8. What order and decree?
