



Order below Exh. 01 in SCC No. 411/2019
(State Vs. Amrut)

1. The Hon'ble High Court directed to conduct special drive programme today vide letter bearing OW No. B/Gen/1001/2026/223 dated 18/02/2026. Accordingly this matter is taken in today's special drive.

2. Perused the record. The alleged offence is punishable under Section 283, 279, 337 and 338 of IPC and Section 184 of MV Act. On going through case record it reveals that there are two accused and accused No. 1 already pleaded guilty and the proceeding extend to him is already disposed off.

3. The matter is pending for securing the presence of accused No. 2, who is resident of another State. In spite of reasonable efforts, presence of accused No. 2 could not procure since last 8 years. Whereabout of the accused No. 2 is unknown. The possibility of tracing accused in near future is seen less. Further-more, it is also seems from record that accused No. 2 is only injured in alleged offence. Thus, considering the nature of offence and proceeding, no purpose would serve to keep the matter as it is for years together. Hence, following order is passed:-

ORDER

1. The proceeding is stopped u/s. 258 of the code of Criminal Procedure.
2. Accused be deemed as discharged u/s. 258 of the Cr.PC.
3. Pending warrant be recalled by Concerned clerk.
