

offence punishable under Section 12-A of The Bombay Prevention of Gambling Act, 1887 and within my cognizance.



The accused filed application stating that, he want to plead guilty. I explained him the consequences of punishment in vernacular. However, he still pleaded guilty to the offence. It appears that, the accused is pleading guilty voluntarily. Hence, I accept his plea as being voluntarily made and proceed to pass the following order.

**ORDER**

- 1) The present case is abated against Accused no.2 Eknath Hiranman Thavkar.
- 2) **Accused no.1. Dilip Dhondbaji Deshmukh, accused no.3. Vijay Shatrughna Borkar, accused no.4. Amar Sudhakar Hatwar, accused no.5. Pankaj Namdeorao Giradkar, accused no.6. Manish Abhimanyu Wankhede, accused no.7. Mahesh Ishwar Bankar, and accused no.8. Vijay Ashok Meshram,** is hereby convicted u/s.252 of Criminal Code of Procedure for the offence punishable u/s.12-A of The Bombay Prevention of Gambling Act, 1887 and he is sentenced to suffer Simple Imprisonment till rising of the Court and directed to pay a fine of Rs.300/- each (Rs. Three Hundred only) in default of payment of fine, they shall suffer S.I. for 15 days (Fifteen days).
- 2) The bail bonds of accused stands surrendered.
- 3) The seized muddemal i.e. Cash of Rs.1130/- (Rs.One Thousand One Hundred thirty only) be credited to the Government.
- 4) The seized muddemal i.e. playing cards being worthless be destroyed after appeal period is over.
