



The accused filed his application stating that, he want to plead guilty. I explained him the consequences of punishment in vernacular. However, he still pleaded guilty to the offence. It appears that, the accused is pleading guilty voluntarily. Hence, I accept his plea as being voluntarily made and proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1) Accused **Nilkanth Chandrabhan Hedau**, is hereby convicted u/s.275 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita for the offence punishable u/s.12-A of The Bombay Prevention of Gambling Act, 1887 and he is sentenced to suffer Simple Imprisonment till rising of the Court and directed to pay a fine of Rs.300/- each (Rs. Three Hundred only each), in default of payment of fine, they shall suffer S.I. for 15 days (Fifteen days).

- 2) The bail bonds of accused stands surrendered.
- 3) The seized muddemal i.e. Cash of Rs.1200/- (Rs.One Thousand Two hundred) be credited to the Government.
- 4) The seized muddemal i.e. three chits of Manipur Satta patti being worthless be destroyed after appeal period is over.
- 5) The seized muddemal i.e. bule pen, be sold out after appeal period is over and it's amount be credited to the Government.
