

The accused are orally stated that, they want to plead guilty. I explained them the consequences of punishment in vernacular. However, they still pleaded guilty to the offence. It appears that, the accused are pleading guilty voluntarily. Hence, I accept their plea as being voluntarily made and proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1) Accused **no.1 Mayur Bhagwat Khobragade, accused no.2. Rahul Shankar Bhoyar, accused no. 3. Domeswar Nilkanth Nandanwar, accused no. 4. Nilesh Kavaduji Gedam and accused no.5 Ashok Manik Gayakwad**, are hereby convicted u/s.275 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita for the offence punishable u/s.12-B of The Bombay Prevention of Gambling Act, 1887 and he is sentenced to suffer Simple Imprisonment till rising of the Court and directed to pay a fine of Rs.300/- each (Rs. Three Hundred only each), in default of payment of fine, they shall suffer S.I. for 15 days (Fifteen days).
- 2) The bail bonds of accused stands surrendered.
- 3) The seized muddemal i.e. Cash of Rs.2750/- (Rs. Two Thousand Seven hundred fifty) and Rs.2000/- of auction of hens be credited to the Government.
