ORDER BELOW EXH.1
(Passed on this 21st day of April, 2026)

1] This is an application for issuance of Heir-ship Certificate under section VIII chapter I of the Bombay Regulation Act, 1827.

2] It is contented by the applicants that, applicant no.1 is the widow, applicant no.2 and 3 are the sons and applicant no.4 is the daughter of deceased Rajendra Natthuji Raut, who died on 16.09.2025 at Neuron Hospital, Nagpur. Deceased Rajendra Natthuji Raut was having Bank account for governmental and non-governmental purpose. The Bank authority has asked for legal heir certificate for processing the claim in respect of account of deceased Rajendra Natthuji Raut. Hence, the applicants being the only legal heirs of deceased Rajendra Natthuji Raut have applied for the legal heirship certificate of deceased Rajendra Natthuji Raut. Deceased Rajendra Natthuji Raut was permanently residing at Sonoli, therefore this Court has territorial jurisdiction to entertain, try and decide the application.

3] The public notice was published in daily "Tarun Bharat" dated 27.02.2026 attached below list of document at Exh.8, but no one is appeared before Court and raised objection. In support of application, applicant No.2 Sachin Raut filed his affidavit at Exh.06. Applicants have produced documents along with list of documents at Exh.04 i.e. verified copy of death

certificate of deceased Rajendra Natthuji Raut at Exh.10, verified copy of Bank Account extract at Exh.11, verified copies of Adhar Cards of all the applicant no.1 to 4 at Exh.12 to 15 respectively, copy of Citation Report at Exh.16 and copy of paper publication at Exh.09.

4] As stated above, in spite of public notice no one has appeared and raised any objection for issuing heirship certificate in name of applicants. Applicant No.2 Sachin has stated on oath that, except them there is no other legal heirs to deceased Rajendra Natthuji Raut. Till today, no one appeared and raised objection to the present application claiming to be the legal heir of deceased Rajendra Natthuji Raut. Therefore, the applicants are the legal heirs of deceased Rajendra Natthuji Raut and thus, they are entitled for the heir-ship certificate. Accordingly, I pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1 Application is hereby allowed.
- 2 Heir-ship certificate be issued in the name of applicant no.1 to 4 as legal heirs of deceased Rajendra Natthuji Raut.
- 3 Applicant to furnish requisite court fees as per rule.
