The instant application is filed by the defendant for permission to file the documents on record.

2. It is contended by the defendant that, he wants to file certain documents on record which include the notice sent to plaintiff and its acknowledgment, House Tax Receipts and other documents of the suit land. Hence, it is urged to allow the application.

3. Plaintiff by filing the say and opposed the application as the documents are being filed at belated stage. Therefore, it be rejected.

4. Heard both sides at length. Perused the record. The defendant wants to file the documents at the stage of evidence. The plaintiff yet not adduced his evidence. It appears that the documents which the defendant wants to file on record are connected with the matter in issue. The said documents includes the notice sent to plaintiff and its acknowledgment, House Tax Receipts and other related documents. The said documents are necessary for the final adjudication of the matter and therefore, the permission to file the same on record needs to be granted. No prejudice would cause to the other side as the plaintiff has every opportunity to

cross-examine the defendant with respect to the said documents. Therefore, for proper adjudication of the matter production of document is necessary. Hence, I pass the following order:

ORDER

1. The application stands allowed subject to costs of Rs. 200/-.
2. The defendant is permitted to file documents on record.
