ORDER BELOW EXH. 27.

Read the application, the other side failed to file say.
Perused the record.

2. The present application filed by the claimants. They submitted that claimant No. 4 and 5 died on 15/08/2023 and 08/03/2023 respectively. Therefore, they want to delete their names from the claim petition.

3. On perusal of the record, it appears that present claim petition is filed under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act. Section 166 deals with the compensation claim for death or injury on road accidents, allowing victims or legal heirs to apply to the Motor Accident Claim Tribunal for compensation. It insuring a social justice frame work for victim. There are five claimants. Out of which claimant No. 4 and 5 died on the dates mentioned above. Therefore, the remaining claimants want to delete their names. The death certificates are filed along with list Exh. 26. As such, claimant No. 4 and 5 died on 15/08/2023 and 08/03/2023 respectively. In such claim cases, compensation is awarded on account of dependency upon the deceased. So, the compensation will be awarded being dependent of deceased person. Other dependent of deceased are already on record. Thus, name of claimant No. 4 and 5 can be deleted from the claim petition. Accordingly, the application deserves to be allowed. Hence, I pass following order -

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. The names of claimant No. 4 and 5 be deleted from the claim petition.
