ORDER BELOW EXH. 1
(Passed on 12th March, 2026)

Nature of proceedings is summary. The charge-sheet is filed for commission of offence under section section 65(e) of Bombay Prohibition Act, 1949. Case is pretty old. On going through case record it reveals that matter is pending to secure presence of accused. C.A. report is filed on record. Considering the nature of offence and proceeding, no purpose would serve to keep the matter as it is for years together.

2] Considering the period passed in between the time keeping the case as it is for years together to secure presence of accused would be of no use, hence, further proceeding is stopped under section 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

3] Accused Deepak Uttam Jadhav is discharged under section 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

4] Seized muddemal property i.e. 39 sealed bottles of country liquor Prince Santra 180 M.L. each be sent to State Excise Department, if not already sent and 6 glasses and 1 plastic mug be auctioned and amount be credited to government.

5] For the foregoing reasons, the proceeding of the instant case is stopped vide section 258 of Code of Criminal Procedure, with liberty to the prosecution to revive the proceeding on the arrest or securing presence of the accused by showing justifiable grounds.

6] The original police papers be retained in "C" file for their use in the event of re-opening the case under section 300(5) of Code of Criminal Procedure.
