

Order below Exh. 1 in Criminal Misc. Application no. 81 of 2025
(Aadhar Shamrao Mali and Ors. Vs. The State of Maharashtra)

[1] Perused the application and material placed on the record. Heard both the sides.

[2] Applicant are accused in C.R. no. 376/2025 registered at Nandgaon Police Station, Tal. Nandgaon, Dist. Nashik. As per the order dated 25.09.2025 passed in Cri. Bail Application No. 859 of 2025 and 857/2025 all the applicant-accused therein were granted bail on certain terms and conditions. One of the conditions being that those accused were directed to attend the concerned police station on every Sunday and Wednesday between 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., until further orders.

[3] It is submitted on behalf of the applicant-accused that the condition of attending the police station periodically is now causing great hardship. Further submitted that investigation in this matter is completed. Charge-sheet is filed in the Court vide R.C.C. no. 10/2026 pending before the J.M.F.C., Nandgaon. Thus, submitted that investigation is completed and Charge-sheet is filed, therefore accused's attendance is not required any more.

[4] Said application is resisted by police filing say at Exh. 6 and the Ld. A.P.P. submitting in case the condition of bail relaxed, accused has no fear of Law, possibility of pressurizing and tampering the witnesses cannot be ruled out. Further submitted that further investigation would be adversely affected. Accordingly resisted the application.

[5] Said application is resisted also by the complainant by filing her objection at Exh. 9 and submitting therein about accused and the relatives pressuring the complainant and her family member to withdraw the complaint. Further submitted that accordingly accused have breached the condition of bail order. Accordingly the complainant has resisted this application.

[6] Perusal of case details filed along with application at Exh. 8 reveals Charge-sheet been filed before the Ld. Magistrate Court, thus, investigation appears to be completed. In such circumstances, accused's attendance at the police station henceforth would not be required.

[7] As far as allegations of complainant been threatened by accused or his relatives, for withdrawal of complaint, it would be pertinent that such allegations are not substantiated by any further complaint filed in police station. Hence, this allegation appears to be made only for the purpose for opposing the present application.

[8] Further complainant's contention of there being breach of condition no. "b" of the bail order, however, that would also be least considerable, as if it would have actually been so, an application by the investigating agency or the complainant would have come up seeking cancellation of bail. However, as nothing as such been brought on record about any bail cancellation application been preferred, thus, this objection also is not much considerable.

[9] Thus for the reasons (supra) investigation been completed

charge-sheet been filed, now, accused's attendance not required at police station, thus, the said condition can be relaxed. Accordingly, the following order :

ORDER

(1) Condition imposed upon applicant-accused **Aadhar Shamro Mali** as per order dated 25.09.2025 in Cri. Bail Application No. 859/2025 and **Ushabai Aadhar Mali, Lokesh Aadhar Mali, Gaurav Aadhar Mali and Milind Aadhar Mali** as per order dated 25.09.2025 in Cri. Bail Application No. 857/2025 directing the applicants to attend the concerned police station on every Sunday and Wednesday between 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., until further orders, is hereby relaxed and accused henceforth need not caused their attendance as per the previous bail order.

(2) Needless to say that other conditions imposed upon the applicant accused as per the said order dated 25.09.2025 shall remain in force.

(3) Inform the concerned police station accordingly.
