

**Sessions Case No. 104/2021.**State Vs. Ravindra Shankar Gaikwad**Order below Exh. 4**

This is an application filed by the applicant/accused under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of bail in Crime No. I-393/2021 for the offences punishable under sections 376(3), 506 of I.P.C. and under sections 4, 5(C)(2), 6, 8 and 12 of POCSO Act registered with Satana Police Station.

02. It is the case of the prosecution that on 07/06/2021 informant- victim-girl lodged the complaint to the police station. She alleged that her parents are blind. Applicant/accused is residing in their vicinity. Under the pretext of marriage and promise of giving the shelter to her blind parents, he kept sexual relations with her. On the basis of her statement, police has registered aforesaid crime against the applicant/accused.

03. Learned A.P.P. S.K. Sonwane filed his say Exh. 5 inter-alia contending that offence is serious and against woman. Applicant/accused has taken the disadvantage of the fact the parents of victim-girl are blind persons. If applicant/accused is released on bail, he will tamper the evidence of prosecution and will pressurize the witnesses. He may commit such type of offence again. Ultimately he sought rejection of application.

04. Heard learned advocate S.K. Bhamare, for the applicant and Ld. A.P.P. S.K. Sonwane, for the State.

05. Perused the documents on record. It appears that this is a first application for bail. Perused the F.I.R. Informant has specifically alleged that under the pretext of promise of marriage and promise of giving the shelter to her blind parents, applicant/accused has kept the physical relations with her. Under such circumstance, I am of the opinion that applicant/accused is not entitled for the bail. Hence, I pass the following order.

**ORDER**

Application is hereby rejected.
