ORDER BELOW Exh.44
(Passed on 20/03/2026)

1. This is an application for bail filed on behalf of accused No.1 and 5, who were arrested in execution of non-bailable warrant and remanded in judicial custody vide order dt. 09/03/2026 passed on Exh.41 and 42 respectively.
2. Ld. APP has opposed the application by submitting that the case is pending since the year 2017 and because of the absence of accused it remained pending, therefore, if bail is granted, the accused No.1 and 5 will not remain present before the Court, therefore, application should be rejected.
3. Heard Ld. Advocate for the accused No.1 and 5 and Ld. APP for the State.
4. Considering the nature of offence and the fact that both the said accused were released on bail previously and considering the submissions in the application, say submitted by the Ld. APP and the oral submissions of both sides, it can be said that accused no.1 and 5 are entitled for bail on certain conditions. Hence, I pass the following order.

ORDER

The application is allowed as under-

1. Accused No.1) Anil Ramesh Sonawane and accused No.5) Machindra Ghuman Sonawane, both r/o. Banainagar, Chandanpuri, Tal. Malegaon Dist. Nashik, be released on bail on their executing P. R. bond of Rs.30,000/- (Rs.Thirty Thousand) each with solvent surety/sureties of the like amount and on following terms and conditions :-

- i. The applicants-accused shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with facts of accusation, so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer.
 - ii. The applicants-accused shall not commit similar kind of offence or any other offence in future.
 - iii. The applicants-accused shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses and evidence in any manner.
2. The applicants-accused or their surety shall furnish detail address and temporary address of the applicants-accused alongwith their Photo ID.
 3. The applicants-accused or their surety shall furnish names and detail address and mobile phone numbers of three close/blood relatives of the applicants-accused.
 4. If there is change in the address of applicants-accused, they shall inform about it to this Court and concerned Police Station.
 5. The applicants-accused to submit their Passport, if any, to the concerned Police Officer of Police Station within 10 days of their release from the Jail.
 6. Inform accordingly, to the D.G.P./PP and Police Officer of concerned Police Station.
