**Cri. (Bail) Application No. 47/2026**

**Shamshoddin Masoddin Sayyad**

**Order Below Exh.1**

This is the application for regular bail filed by applicant /accused **Shamshoddin Masoddin Sayyad** as per Section 483 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita in connection with C.R. No.49/2026 registered with Chandwad Police Station for the offences punishable under Sections 5A, 5B, 9 of The Maharashtra Protection of Animals Act, under Section 11(1)(d) of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, under Section 325 of Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita and under Section 119 of Maharashtra Police Act, on the basis of FIR given by informant Police Constable Vikram Vinayakrao Vadge.

2. It is case of the prosecution as per First Information Report that according to the informant, on 05.02.2026, he was on duty in police station Chandwad from 8-00 p.m. to 8-00 a.m. of 06.02.2026. They received secret information that on Manmad-Malegaon Road, at Kanadgaon Shivar illegal transportations of the cattle are going on. Accordingly, police laid trap at Kanadgaon Panpoi Phata. They saw one truck no.MH-16-AE-5789 standing there and during search, they found 19 cows kept in the said truck in cruel manner for the purpose of slaughtering

and three cows were found dead. Accordingly, police arrested the present accused who was driver of the said vehicle and lodged F.I.R.

3. According to the applicant / accused he is falsely implicated in the matter. According to him, now investigation is over and considering the nature of the offence, there is no need to keep him in jail. Accordingly, he prayed to grant bail.

4. Present application is strongly opposed by Ld. A.P.P. by filing say at Exh.4.

5. Heard Ld. Advocate for applicants /accused and Ld. A.P.P. at length. Perused the investigation papers. On going through the entire material, it is clear that the ground raised by prosecution to object the bail application are vague in nature. Accused is in jail for more than one month. There is no past criminal history of the accused brought on record by the prosecution. Merely because the few accused are absconding, can not be a ground to deny bail to the present accused. Offence is exclusively triable by J.M.F.C. Court. Investigation is almost over. Therefore, following order.

#### ORDER

- 1) Application is allowed.
- 2) **Applicant /Accused Shamshoddin Masoddin Sayyad in C.R.No.49/2026 of Chandwad Police Station** be released on bail in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) with one surety in the like amount and upon following conditions;
  - (a) That applicant/ accused shall not cause inducement or

threaten the prosecution witnesses.

- (b) That the applicant /accused shall furnish the information regarding his current address, mobile contact number and shall inform if there is change in mobile number and address from time to time.
- 3) Bail before concern J.M.F.C. Court
- 4) Inform concerned police station. So also inform the accused through Superintendent of concerned jail by sending soft copy of this order by e-mail.
