This is the application for regular bail filed by applicant /accused Ajay Chandrakant Lilke as per Section 483 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita in connection with C.R. No.282/2025 registered with Pimpalgaon Police Station for the offences punishable under Sections 118(2), 109(1), 351(2) r/w 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita on the basis of FIR given by informant Santosh Shivaji Wagh.

2. It is case of the prosecution as per First Information Report that according to the informant, on 04.09.2025, at about 7-00p..m., accused along with his wife came in front of house of informant and started asking why Lalit i.e. son of the informant is calling wife of the accused and there is affair between them. Thereafter, some call recording was heard by the parties and then accused threatened the son of the informant. On 12.10.2025, at about 9-30 p.m., Lalit went to his job on his motorcycle at M/s Signature International Food India Pvt. Ltd., Pimpalgaon Baswant. Mahesh Jadhav i.e. friend of informant called him at Om Hospital, Pimpalgaon. Then, it revealed that on 12.10.2025 at about 9-55 p.m. on Mukhed MIDC Road, near mobile tower, Pimpalgaon Baswant ahead of Ambika Nagar, accused along with one unknown person followed Lalit and

obstructed him and accused Chandrakant i.e. present applicant gave blow of sharp weapon on the backside of the head, backside of neck, both the shoulders, back and little finger of right hand and caused him grievous injuries. Accordingly, F.I.R. is given.

3. On the basis of F.I.R. Police started investigation and arrested the accused. Seized the muddemal and weapon, recorded statement of witnesses and on completion of investigation submitted charge-sheet and now it is pending before Sessions Court, Niphad bearing Sessions Case No.21/2026.

4. According to the applicant / accused he is falsely implicated in the matter. According to him, there was love affair between victim and the wife of the accused. There is no grievous injury and therefore, Section 109 of Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita will not attract. Investigation is now over and he prayed to grant bail.

5. Present application is strongly opposed by prosecution by filing say at Exh.3.

6. Heard Ld. Advocate for applicant /accused and Ld. A.P.P. at length. Perused the investigation papers. Investigating Officer is present in the Court.

7. On going through the entire material, it appears that already weapon is seized by police. There is no injury on the vital part of the body of the injured of grievous nature which endangers his life. Though, there is one certificate under the style as Medico-Legal Certificate, issued by Om Multi-Speciality Hospital, the issuing doctor is not orthopedic surgeon and no documents of admission, operation, indoor case papers, treatment

papers and discharge summary are produced on record by the prosecution though charge-sheet is filed. Accused is in jail since long. Regular Court is vacant due to transfer of Presiding Officer. There is no likelihood that in near future trial will commence and conclude early. Therefore, there is no reason to keep the accused in jail for indefinite period.

ORDER

- 1) Application is allowed.
- 2) **Applicant/Accused Ajay Chandrakant Lilke in C.R.No.282 /2025 of Pimpalgaon (B) Police Station [Sessions Case No.21/2026]** be released on bail in the sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) with one surety in the like amount and upon following conditions;
 - (a) That applicant/ accused shall not cause inducement or threaten the prosecution witnesses.
 - (b) That the applicant /accused shall furnish the information regarding his current address, mobile contact number and shall inform if there is change in mobile number and address from time to time.
- 3) Inform concerned police station. So also inform the accused through Superintendent of concerned jail by sending soft copy of this order by e-mail.
