**Order below Exh.1**

This application under Section 503 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita is filed by the applicant for custody of seized Bajaj Discover Motorcycle bearing Registration No.MH-15-FD-1290. The said motorcycle is seized by Police Station Niphad in above mentioned crime.

2. Read the application and say of Police Exh.5. Heard both sides.
3. It is clear from the application that the said motorcycle is owned by the applicant. According to him, the said motorcycle is required for his personal use. According to him, if motor is kept idle in the police station, it will rust.
4. Considering the nature of allegations, therefore, there is no need to keep the vehicle idle in the police station. If vehicle is kept idle, it will rust and will damage. Therefore, following order.

**ORDER**

- 1) Application is allowed.
- 2) **Seized Bajaj Discover Motorcycle bearing Registration No.MH-15-FD-1290 having Chassis No. MD2A15BZ3FWF17614 Engine No. JZZWFF37441** be returned to the applicant/registered owner Pathan Afjal Anvar on his executing Indemnity Bond in the sum of Rs.75,000/- (Rupees Seventy Five Thousand Only) on following conditions;
  - (a) Applicant shall not change the nature of the said Bajaj Discover motorcycle by any way and shall not make any mechanical changes or technical changes in the said motorcycle.
  - (b) Applicant shall not sale, gift, mortgage the said motorcycle and shall not create any type of third party interest of whatsoever nature over the said motorcycle.
  - (c) Applicant shall not change colour of the said motorcycle.
  - (d) Applicant is directed to keep the said motorcycle in good working condition.
  - (e) Applicant shall produce the said motorcycle either before Investigating Officer or in the Court if required for inquiry, investigation and trial as and when directed accordingly.
  - (f) Applicant shall not allow to use the said motorcycle for commission of any other crime.

- (g) If applicant commits breach of any of the conditions as above, he shall be liable to pay Rs.75,000/-(Rupees Seventy Five Thousand Only) lumpsum to the Government.
- 3) Investigating Officer shall prepare detail panchanama of the vehicle and take colour photographs of the said motorcycle from all angles while returning it to the applicant and shall return the same along with panchanama to the Court along with charge-sheet.
- 4) Police Station Niphad is directed to intimate this order to R.T.O. Nashik / concerned R.T.O. for necessary entry in the register so that applicant shall not create any third party interest over the said motorcycle by any way and report compliance.
- 5) Application disposed off.
