ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN
CIVIL MISCELLANEOUS APPLICATION NO.04 OF 2026

01] The applicants have requested to issue legal Heirship Certificate under provisions of Bombay Regulation Act,1827.

02] The applicants have contended that deceased V. Ravindran died on 04/12/2001 at Ozhar Township, Ozhar, Tal.Niphad, Dist.Nashik. Applicant No.1 is widow and applicant's No.2 to 5 are children of deceased V. Ravindran. The applicants require heirship certificate for getting benefit of Government and Non-Government works. Hence, this application.

03] Proclamation was issued in daily newspaper "Deshdoot" date 22/01/2026. But, nobody appeared to resist the claim of applicants. In support of claim, applicant No.2 has filed her affidavit (Exh.12) and reiterated contents of application. According to her, deceased V. Ravindran was died on 04/12/2001. She is widow of deceased V. Ravindran and applicants No.2 to 5 are their children. The applicant filed additional affidavit (Exh.13) and stated that Madhu Unnicho Valiakath, mother of deceased V. Ravindran is also deceased.

04] The applicants have filed copy of death certificate of

deceased V. Ravindran. Despite publication in the newspaper, nobody appeared and resisted the claim of applicants. There is no reason to disbelieve the applicants. It appears from the record that applicants are only legal heirs of deceased V. Ravindran. Thus, following order is passed.

ORDER

1]	Application is allowed.
2]	Issue Heirship Certificate in names of applicants as legal heirs of deceased V. Ravindran , as per rules on payment of court fees.
3]	Pronounced in open Court.
