ORDER BELOW EXH.NO.91

This is an application filed **accused no.6 Kailas Shakar Kamod**. This is the case for the offence punishable U/Sec.193, 196, 199, 209, 211, 499, 500 r/w 120 of the Indian Penal Code. In this application it is submitted by accused no.6 that, he is businessman. The accused no.6 requires to visit different countries for business purpose. Therefore, he had passport which now requires to be renewed. Accordingly, he applied to passport authority for renewal. However, as the applicant is made accused in R.C.C. No.26/2019 and the same is pending before Court of law. Accused requires No Objection Certificate to extent validity of passport in the name of the accused no.6. The accused no.6 is not having any knowledge about the aforesaid case filed against him. Passport of applicant / accused no.6 was valid from 05/04/2016 to 04/04/2026. As the validity of said passport is over, he needs to extent validity of same. Hence, this application.

2. The complainant opposed the application by filing his say on the overleaf. He submitted that, if the said application allowed, then there is possibility that present accused will not remain present at the time of trial. Hence, he prayed to reject the application.

3. Heard Ld.Advocates for the accused and complainant. Considered their submissions. On perusal of record it appears that, applicant has filed photocopy of letter issued by Passport Office, Mumbai, verified copy of passport and verified copy of Aadhar Card of accused no.6 below the list Exh.93. It is seen that, case is pending since last 6 years. The accused no.6 Kailas Shakar Kamod is permanent residence of Flat no.A-

801 and 802, Vivan Apartment, near Panchavati Dental College, Panchavati, Nashik. Verified copy of passport of accused no.6 reveals that, the date of issuance of passport is 05/04/2016 and the date of expiry of passport is 04/04/2026. Considering the nature of the proceeding I have no hesitation to allow the application on condition that, accused no.6 to report his whereabouts before leaving the country and also on his return to the country. Accused no.6 shall undertake that, trial would not hamper because of his absence in any way.

4. Subject to what is observed above, permission in regard to issuance of No Objection Certificate for renewal of passport is granted in the interest of justice and in result I pass following order;

ORDER

1. The application below Exh.No.91 is allowed.
2. Issue No Objection Certificate in the name of **accused no.6 Kailas Shakar Kamod**, permanent residence of Flat no.A-801 and 802, Vivan Apartment, near Panchavati Dental College, Panchavati, Nashik for extension of validity of passport.
