ORDER BELOW APPLICATION EXH. NO.19

(Passed on this 07th August, 2025)

01. The accused no.1 to 4 made this application seeking permission to travel Abroad for religious purpose.

02. It is contended by the applicants that they belongs to muslim community and they want to visit the Haj for religious purpose. They have been arraigned as accused in R.C.C. No. 59/2024 registered in the Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Pimpalgon (B) for the offence punishable under Sections 323, 324, 504, 506, r/w 34 of I.P.C. which incident took place in the year 2023. They are released on bail. Passport authority had directed to furnish the N.O.C. from this Court. They are ready to abide by the terms and conditions which this Court may impose. Hence, they prayed to permit them to travel to Abroad for religious purpose.

03. Ld. A. P. P. filed his say. He objected the application on the ground that, if the accused are permitted to travel abroad they may abscond. In the absence of the accused trial cannot proceed further. He submitted that applicant has not furnished

any kind of documents in support of their application. Hence, he prayed that, the application may be rejected.

04. The trial is already begun. The informant and injured are the relatives of the accused. Therefore, as the undertaking given by the learned advocate for the accused the question of identification would not be raised. Therefore, it would not fatal the prosecution evidence and the trial. Further, they intends to return after their religious visit is over. There are no chances of their fleeing away or causing delay in the trial. Hence, considering stage of the matter no objection can be given to accused to travel abroad. Hence, I am inclined to grant the application. Hence, I pass following order:-

ORDER

- 01.** The application Exh.No.19 is allowed in following terms.
- a)** This Court gives no objection to the Passport Authority to allow accused applicant no.1 to 4 to travel Abroad, if they are qualified as per their rules.
 - b)** This Court has given no objection for only in respect of R.C.C. No.59/2024 State vs. Mohsin Pathan & Others instituted at the instance of The State of

Maharashtra Through Pimpalgaon (B) Police Station, Tal. Niphad, Dist. Nashik bearing Crime Register No.240/2023 in the Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Pimpalgaon (B) as R.C.C. No.59/2024 to travel abroad for the religious purpose.

- c) The accused applicant no. 1 to 4 are directed to take certified copy of this application and order for production of it before concerning Passport Authority.
- d) The Passport Authority shall act on the duly certified copy of this order issued by the office bearer of this Court. It can be verified from official web-site of Indian Courts.
- e) Inform this order to the Police Station, Pimpalgaon (B) for necessary action.
