ORDER PASSED BELOW EXH.1 IN
REGULAR CIVIL SUIT NO.66 OF 2013

1] Power-of-attorney holder i.e. Manjiram Jagannath Kushare has filed pursis (Exh.47) for withdrawal of the suit. He has contended that the present suit is in respect of mandatory injunction and fixation of boundary marks of Gat No.239. The plaintiff has thereafter filed suit against same defendants in respect of Gat No.239 and 240. Therefore, the plaintiff does not want to proceed with the present suit. He wants to withdraw the suit.

2] Power-of-attorney of the plaintiff is filed at Exh.39/1. It appears that power-of-attorney holder is husband of the plaintiff. The plaintiff has given all powers to power-of-attorney holder in respect of present suit. Hence, I find it that the plaintiff is entitled to withdraw the suit. However, it is necessary to direct him to pay costs of the suit to the

defendants. Accordingly, I pass the following order,

ORDER

- [i] The suit stands withdrawn.
- [ii] The plaintiff shall pay costs of the suit to the defendants and bear her own.
- [iii] Court fees be refunded as per rules.
