### ORDER

The accused voluntarily pleads guilty for the offence of which particulars are now read over and explained to him. He pleaded guilty. I have explained him with the consequences of plead guilty and of maximum punishment, even though he is ready to admit his guilt, thus, I found that he is voluntarily pleading guilty. Hence, I accept the plea of guilty of the accused and hold him guilty for the said offence. The purpose of pleading guilty and releasing him on minimum fine became futile excise as accused does not prevent himself for committing another crime. Heard the accused on the point of sentence. He submitted that he is the only earning member of his family. Considering the nature of offence, facts and circumstances of the case and the provision in the law as well as the financial status of accused, I proceed to pass the following order.

### ORDER

1] Accused is convicted for an offence punishable under Section 66(1) punishable under section 192-A of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 and he is sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 2,000/- (Rs. Two Thousand only). In default of payment of fine he shall suffer further simple imprisonment for 10 days.
