



ORDER BELOW EXH. 26

Perused the application and say. Heard learned counsel for both parties.

2] On perusal record of the suit, it appears that applicant / defendant has prayed for setting aside No Cross Order passed against him on 30.09.2025. The application is opposed by the other side. However, the reason stated by the applicant for setting aside “No Cross Order” appears to be just and reasonable. Hence, taking into consideration the grounds mentioned in the application and in the interest of justice and also to avoid further multiplicity of proceeding, at this stage, “No Cross Order” deserves to be set aside. Hence, I pass the following order:

ORDER

1. Application is hereby allowed subject to cost of Rs.300/-. Which is to be deposited in legal aid on or before next date.
2. “No Cross Orders” passed below Exh. 16 dated 30.09.2025 against the applicant/defendant is hereby set aside.
3. Applicant/defendant is permitted to conduct cross examination on payment of cost imposed in sub clause 1 of this order.
