Deposition of witness No.06 for the prosecution :

I do hereby state on oath or solemn affirmation that,

My Name is Dr. Yogesh Ramkrushna Dhanwate,

Aged about 49 Years., Occu. -Medical Officer

R/o. Pimpalgaon B., Tal.Niphad.

Examination in chief for prosecution by Ld. A.P.P. Shri S.L.Jorwar :-

01. I am serving as medical officer since 2017 at P.H.C. Pimpalgaon(B). On 28/06/2018 patient namely Ashok Manohar Gangurde was came to the causality. He narrated me the history of assault.

02. On examination, I found the following injuries :-

Injury 1 : Fracture on shaft of left humerus.

Injury 2 : Blunt trauma over body.

03. Injuries were caused by a hard and blunt object. Injuries were of grievous in nature. In my opinion, the injuries would be caused by a wooden stick Article – A. The medical examination report dated 28/06/2018 bears my signature and P.H.C. seal. Now the medico-legal certificate dated 28/06/2018 is shown to me. It bears my signature and seal. It is marked as **Exh.46**. Patient namely Ashok Manohar Gangurde was referred to Civil Hospital, Nashik for

further treatment and X-ray was advised to him.

Chief Examination is over.

Cross examination by Ld. Adv. Shri. R.R.Mundada for the accused:-

04. It is true to say that, Exh.46 has no mention of age of injury and size of injury. It is true to say that, Exh.46 does not bear thumb impression or signature of patient namely Ashok Manohar Gangurde. I do not remember who had produced medico-legal case register of certificate of Civil Hospital, Nashik. It is true to say that, today I have not brought X-ray report of Ashok Manohar Gangurde. After 8-10 days of the incident Civil Hospital report was produced. It is true to say that, P.H.C., Pimpalgaon maintains inward outward register. Today I have not brought the outward register to show that on 28/06/2018 Ashok Manohar Gangurde was referred to Civil Hospital, Nashik for further treatment. It is true to say that, injuries similar to those described in an assault case could also occur due to a fall from a motorcycle.

05. It is true to say that, while going through the assault cases it is mandatory and advisory to inform the police about such injured. It is true to say that, Exh.46 does not mention assault time.

06. It is not true to say that, today I am deposing false. It is not true to say that, I have issued a false certificate Exh.46. It is not true to say that the report was prepared at the instance of the police.

It is not true to say that, the injuries mentioned are fabricated.

Cross examination is over.

No Re-examination.
