The present application is filed by the plaintiff for bringing the legal representatives of Plaintiff on record.

2. Defendant filed his say on the backleaf of the said application stating therein that, said application is not filed within limitation and this plaintiff has not assigned just and reasonable ground for delay hence, his application liable to be rejection if Court opinions that, the application be allowed the cost imposed upon this plaintiff and given to this defendant.

2. Legal representatives of the deceased plaintiff mentioned in the present application be taken on record within 14 days from the date of this order.
