Order below Exh. 1 in Civil M. A. No.9/2026

Applicants have filed the present application under Section 2 of the Bombay Regulation Act, VII, 1827 for Heirship Certificate of Late – Kantilal Sitaram Bahiram.

2] **Brief facts of the applicant case:**

Deceased Kantilal Sitaram Bahiram is husband of applicant no.1 and father of applicant no.2 respectively. Kantilal Sitaram Bahiram died on 01/04/2025. Therefore, applicants are in need of heirship certificate of deceased Kantilal Sitaram Bahiram for the purpose of getting a job on compassionate grounds. Except applicants, there is no legal heirs of deceased Kantilal Sitaram Bahiram. Therefore, applicants applied to grant of heirship certificate.

3] Accordingly, citation notice and paper publication was issued, but no one has taken any objection.

4] The following are the points which arose for my determination along-with my findings thereon.

As to Point No. 1 and 2 :-

5] In order to substantiate his claim, applicant no.1 Rohinibai Kantilal Bahiram (AW 1) has filed his evidence-affidavit at Exh. 11. Nobody has taken the objection to grant heirship certificate in favour of applicants.

6] Applicants have also relied on various documentary evidence i.e. A] Copy of death certificate of deceased Kantilal Sitaram Bahiram, B] Copy of death certificate of deceased Kashibai Sitaram Bahiram C] Verified copy of Aadhar card of Applicant no.1 and 2 D] Verified copy of ration card of deceased and applicants E] Paper notice published in the newspaper "Aapla Mahanagar" dtd.07/04/2026 at Exh. 10 and F] Proclamation report at Exh.07.

07] From the perusal of evidence affidavit of applicant no.1 and documents produced by applicants and considering the ground that, nobody has objected to issue the heirship certificate to applicants, it appears that, applicants are legal heirs of the said deceased person namely Kantilal Sitaram Bahiram. Claim of applicants stand un rebutted. Thus, I have no hesitation to grant Heirship Certificate in favour of applicants. Hence, I answer point no.1 in affirmative & I proceed to pass following order.

:- O R D E R :-

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] Issue Heirship Certificate under Bombay Regulation Act, VIII, 1827 of deceased namely - Late Kantilal Sitaram Bahiram in favour of applicants on deposit of requisite court fee stamp.
- 3] Applicants to bears their own cost.
